1 Samuel 16:1-13



God tells Samuel to anoint the next king. Samuel sees Jesse's oldest son and thinks he must be the one. But God looks at the heart, not outward appearance. God helps us see people through his eyes, and he helps Samuel see that the king is the youngest son, David.
